



Updated Travel Policy - May 4, 2021

Greetings from Hope! I want to provide you with the most recent updates on our school's travel policy. Today's update supersedes the original policy which was released on November 17, 2020. This updated policy is based on the April 2, 2021 travel guidelines from the CDC and the California Department of Public Health and San Mateo County's updated Pandemic Recovery Framework for Schools of April 23, 2021.

With the pandemic in an upsurge in many parts of the world, I would like to discourage you from international travel. If international travel is essential, please follow the policy below:

A fully vaccinated* traveler who traveled *internationally* must self-quarantine for 10 days before returning to HOPE campus symptom-free.

Special Notes:

As children are currently not qualified to be vaccinated, HOPE students will need to be quarantined for 7 days after returning from outside of California or domestic travel.

HOPE students will also need to quarantine for 7 days if unvaccinated visitor(s) from outside California are staying with the student's household.
